

# Duke of Edinburgh

Pupils taking part in the **Duke of Edinburgh Award** will have the opportunity to develop skills & knowledge across 3 key areas of personal attainment (Volunteering, Physical & Skills) which is led by the pupil themselves and supported by members of staff who are trained to deliver the course.

Along with completing the 3 sections above, pupils will cover topics such as first aid, map reading, navigation, wild cooking/camping along with developing self-reliance & coping strategies.

The culmination of this training will be the Expedition phase where pupils will be assessed on their knowledge, leading to their Bronze award.
