COURSE CONTENT: What will I Learn?

The course is divided into three units

- 1. Geographical Methods and Techniques in this unit you will look at both physical and human fieldwork techniques. This will include some fieldwork. In addition you will study statistical techniques and look in detail at the production and interpretation of maps and diagrams
- 2. The Geographical Study In this unit you will plan, collect, present and analyse information to produce a report.
- 3. Geographical Issues- In this unit you will research different viewpoints on two geographical issues. You will produce analytical summaries of these and then produce critical evaluations of the different viewpoints.

TEACHING METHODS: what will I do?

- One to one guidance on material chosen

ASSESSMENT: How will I be assessed?
