Pupils will either gain National 4 or National 5 Modern Studies.

- What is terrorism?
- Causes and consequences of terrorism
- Attempts at resolving terrorism



# **TEACHING METHODS: what will I do?**

- Reading and note taking using text and articles
- Completing source questions
- IT research to find up to date statistics such as election results
- Discussion of key issues
- Group work tasks involving presentation of your findings
- Using research methods such as surveys and watching documentaries

### ASSESSMENT:

As well as informal testing in the form of quizzes, mini tests and questioning pupils sitting National 5 need to sit an exam (60 marks) and complete as assignment (20 marks) both of which is marked by the exam board.

National 4 pupils need to pass unit assessments as well as complete an Added Value project.



#### **HOMEWORK**

- Regular homework will be given out. Due to the amount of content, pupils will be encouraged to review their notes on a regular basis at home.
- Past paper questions, especially the source questions, will be set as homework to practise the skills required.
- Revision will be required for assessments and end of unit tests.
- Pupils are also encouraged to keep up to date with the news in Scotland, UK and the world through watching the news, reading newspapers, online news and social media newsfeeds.

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### PROGRESSION IN THE SENIOR PHASE

If you complete National 4 to a high standard, you can progress to National 5 Modern Studies next year. If you complete National 5 to a good standard then you have the option to progress to Higher Modern Studies.
