## **Entry Level: What do I need to do it?**

You need to be in S5/6 and to have already shown a commitment and a willingness to learn and to practise, both in class and at home. Previous language learning beyond S3 is an advantage.

## **Course Content: What will I learn?**

You will develop the four skills of Talking, Listening, Reading and Writing. We work on the themes of Society & Culture and Learning & Employability.

## **Teaching Methods: What will I do?**

You will work in a variety of ways, including pair work, group discussion, problem solving and individual tasks, to enhance and develop your foreign language skills. Activities include films, job interviews and understanding of different texts. Discussion of current events in the country of language study is also an important priority.

## **Assessment: How will I be assessed?**

All four skills of Reading, Listening, Talking and Writing are assessed. In addition, at National 4 level, there is a project – the Added Value Unit – which involves reading tasks, a presentation with some follow-up questions – on a topic chosen with the support of the class teacher.

## **Homework.**

You will work in a variety of ways, including pair work, group discussion, problem solving and individual tasks, to enhance and develop your foreign language skills.
